Mayor Gehrig called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**Resolution 202401:** Resolution 2024 is a resolution to seek funding from the Johnson County Recreation District in the amount of \$8,000.00 for a new lawn tractor. Councilwoman Davis moved to approve the resolution as presented. Councilwoman Lompe seconded. Motion carried.

**Street Closure:** The Council was presented with a request from the Chris LeDoux Memorial Foundation to close a portion of Nolan Avenue from June 14<sup>th</sup> – June 16<sup>th</sup>. Councilwoman Lompe moved to approve the closure as presented. Councilwoman Davis seconded. Motion carried.

**Updates/Correspondence:**

1. The PRFD agreed for the Town to pay their \$4,000 contract this year and install the backflow preventer and meter next year, due to the difficulty in receiving parts.
2. Water leaks are currently being repaired.
3. The backhoe tires are showing signs of wear. Councilman Knapp said new ones are easy to get if needed.
4. The lead and copper inventory are taking place before the October deadline.
