Hugh Turk (Johnson County Rec. Board) – Mr. Turk answered any questions the council had regarding the current recreation board. Mr. Turk stated that the regular grant cycle will proceed this year with applications being due April 29th.

Building Permit 201602 – The Council was presented with a building permit from Ms. Karen Garrett. Ms. Garrett is requesting permission to extend the fence on the North side of her property located at 327 Ritter Avenue, and to replace the existing fence on the South side of the property. There being no public comment, Councilwoman Davis moved to approve the building permit, seconded by Councilwoman Lompe. *Vote: 4 ayes.*
