September 27, 2022

Mayor Gehrig called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

NEW BUSINESS:

Complaint: The Council reviewed a complaint regarding diseased feral cats in town. A call has been put into the predator board for assistance.

Additional Office Help: An ad will be placed for part-time help in the Town Hall. The position will be for approximately eight hours per month.

Surveying: Mayor Gehrig discussed having a few areas surveyed for accurate property line information. The Council was in agreement that the information would be helpful.

OLD BUSINESS:

Complaint Follow Up: The landowner has been contacted regarding the barking dog and weeds complaint.

LEGAL ISSUES:

Parking in Street and Use of Town Right of Way: A letter was sent to the resident parking in street/blocking traffic. Mayor Gehrig spoke with the resident and the issue is resolved.

Nuisance Ordinance: Mr. Crago is in the process of putting the nuisance ordinance into draft form.

MINUTES: Councilwoman Davis moved to approve the minutes from the regular meeting held on September 13th as presented. Councilwoman Lompe seconded. Motion carried.
